

ENTRANCE EXAM IN ENGLISH I YEAR

The interview lasts approximately 10-15 minutes. A student is given a speaking topic card, after which he/she takes several minutes to think about the topic. A student is not allowed to make any written notes, but can ask questions about the content of the speaking card. The maximum amount of points awarded is 10.

SAMPLE TOPIC 1:

● Travel

People are travelling further and more often than ever.

Discuss this topic with the examiner.

Use the following prompts, in the order given below, to develop the conversation:

- how you prefer to travel to places
- the advantages and disadvantages of various forms of transport
- whether it's better to travel more in your home country, or to travel abroad
- the suggestion that the journey is more interesting than the destination
- what might happen if air travel was banned for a year

You may introduce **related** ideas of your own to expand on these prompts.

Remember, you are not allowed to make any written notes.

SAMPLE TOPIC 2:

● Behaviour

People gain a good or bad impression of us from the way that we behave.

Discuss this topic with the examiner.

Use the following prompts, in the order given below, to develop the conversation:

- what good behaviour means to you
- your own behaviour in school, at home and with friends
- how well or badly behaved other people you know are
- reasons why people might find it difficult to behave well at certain times
- the suggestion that public figures need to be aware of their behaviour at all times.

You may introduce **related** ideas of your own to expand on these prompts.

Remember, you are not allowed to make any written notes.
